

## **Depth of Field using Aperture Priority.**

### **Set-up:**

**On a table set up three objects: (toys, flowers, cups, etc.)**

- 1. Place the first object directly in front of the camera about 2 feet away.**
- 2. Second object should be 1 foot away beyond the first.**
- 3. Third object 1 foot beyond the second.**

**Stagger sideways the objects so they are all visible.**

- 1. Set the camera on Aperture priority mode.**
- 2. Set ISO to Auto**
- 3. Set focus dot to camera's central focus point.**
- 4. Set your aperture to the smallest f-number (1.8 - 2.8 - 3.5)**
- 5. Point your camera at the first object so the active focus point is on it. Take a picture**
- 6. Without moving your camera change the aperture to f8. Take a picture**
- 7. Change the aperture to f22 or even higher. Take a picture.**
- 8. Next: change your focus point to the second object, so it is sharp and repeat the above steps.**
- 9. Change your focus point to the third object, and repeat.**
