What is Fixed-in-Post?

Background

- **Most photographs need some level of editing or enhancement**
- **Editing techniques can range from simple corrections to more complex enhancements**



Editing Tools

- ✓ **In-camera tools (special functions)**
 - sunset, snow, beach, night, aquarium, etc.

- ✓ **Post-processing tools**
 - Photoshop Elements
 - Photoshop Creative Suite
 - Lightroom
 - Numerous free or low-cost editing programs
 - Smartphone applications



Editing Techniques

- **There is an endless variety of editing techniques from straight-forward to more complex, multi-step enhancements**

- **Examples include:**
 - **Simple Fixes:**
 - Red-eye removal
 - Straighten horizon
 - Cropping
 - Exposure adjustment

 - **More Challenging Fixes/Enhancements:**
 - Hue/Saturation
 - Tonal Adjustment
 - Shadows/Highlights

The list goes on and on and on…………

- **highlights/shadows, cropping**
- **hue/saturation**
