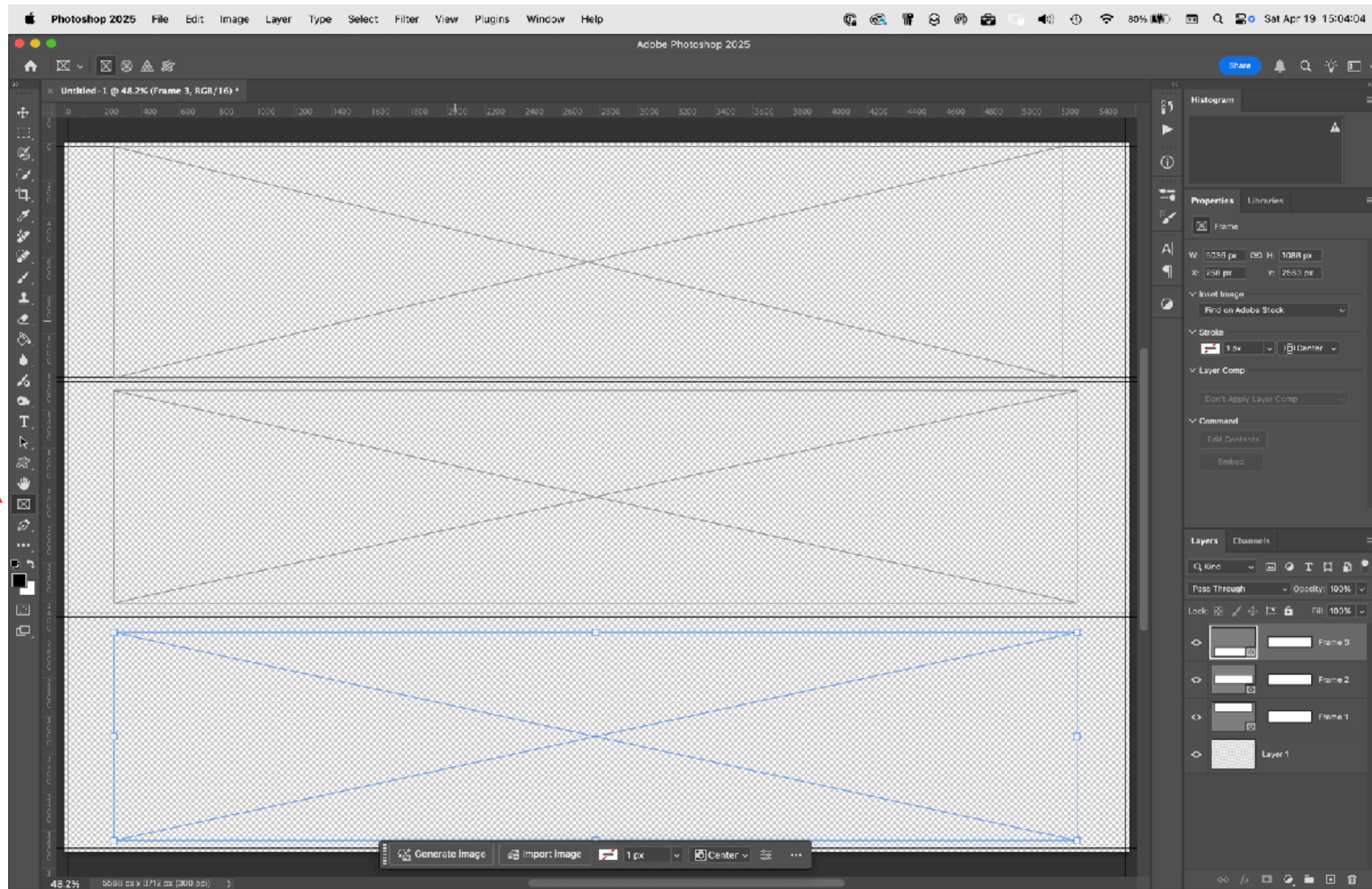
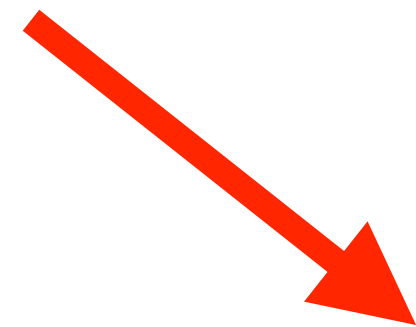
Start off with a new transparent document.



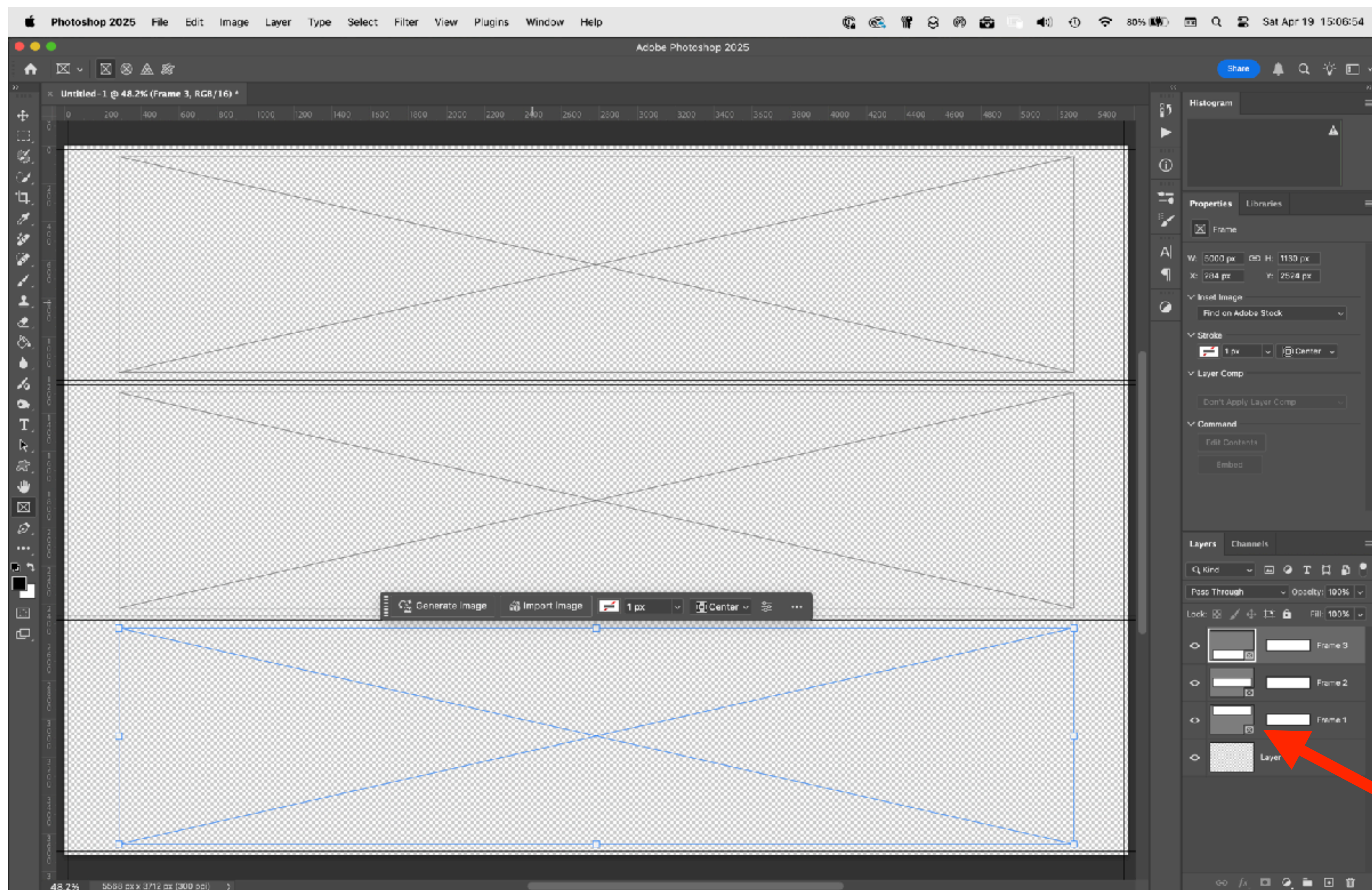
Guide tool in

Tool



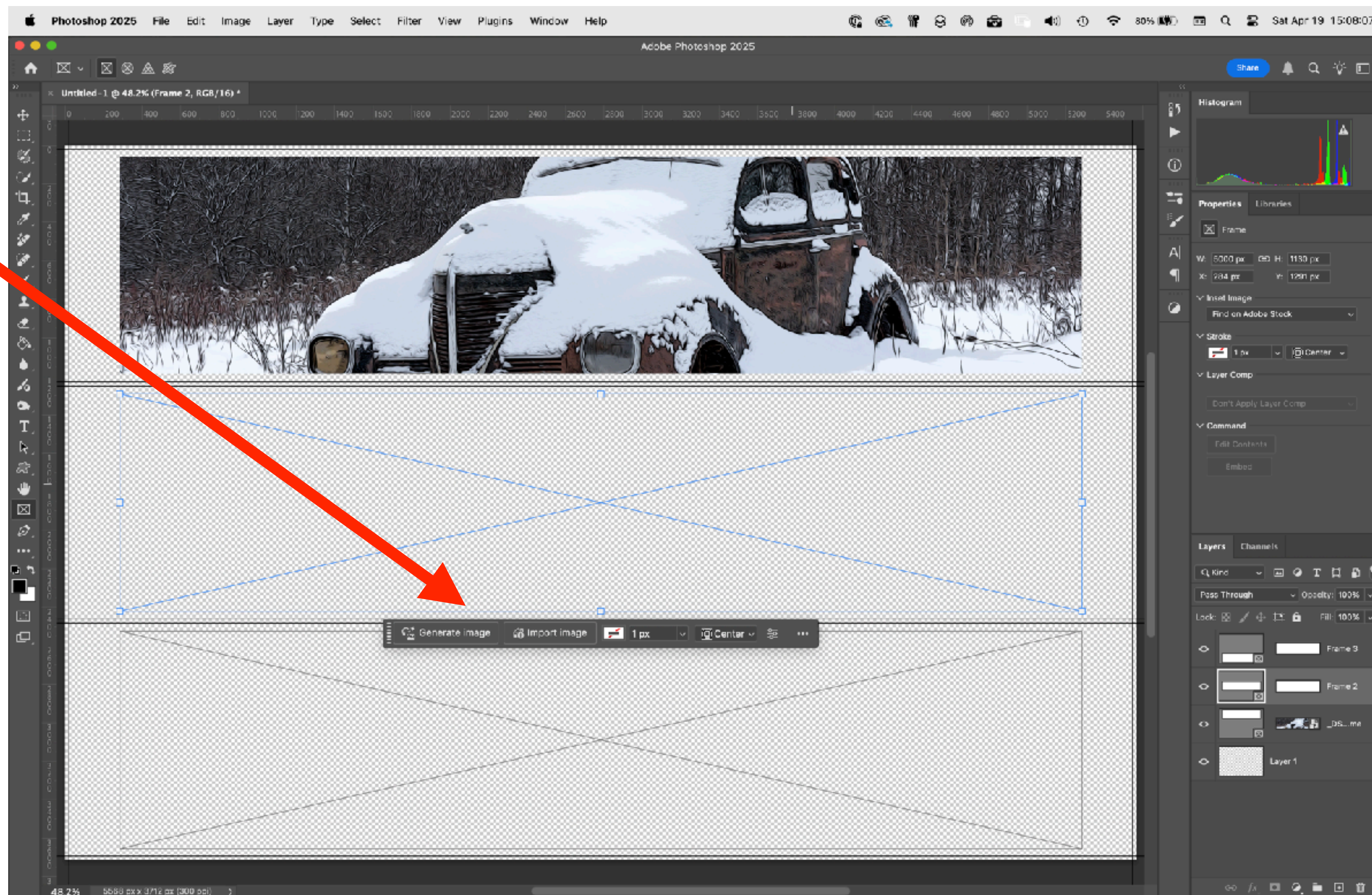
Create three frames — don't worry about the size of each frame yet.



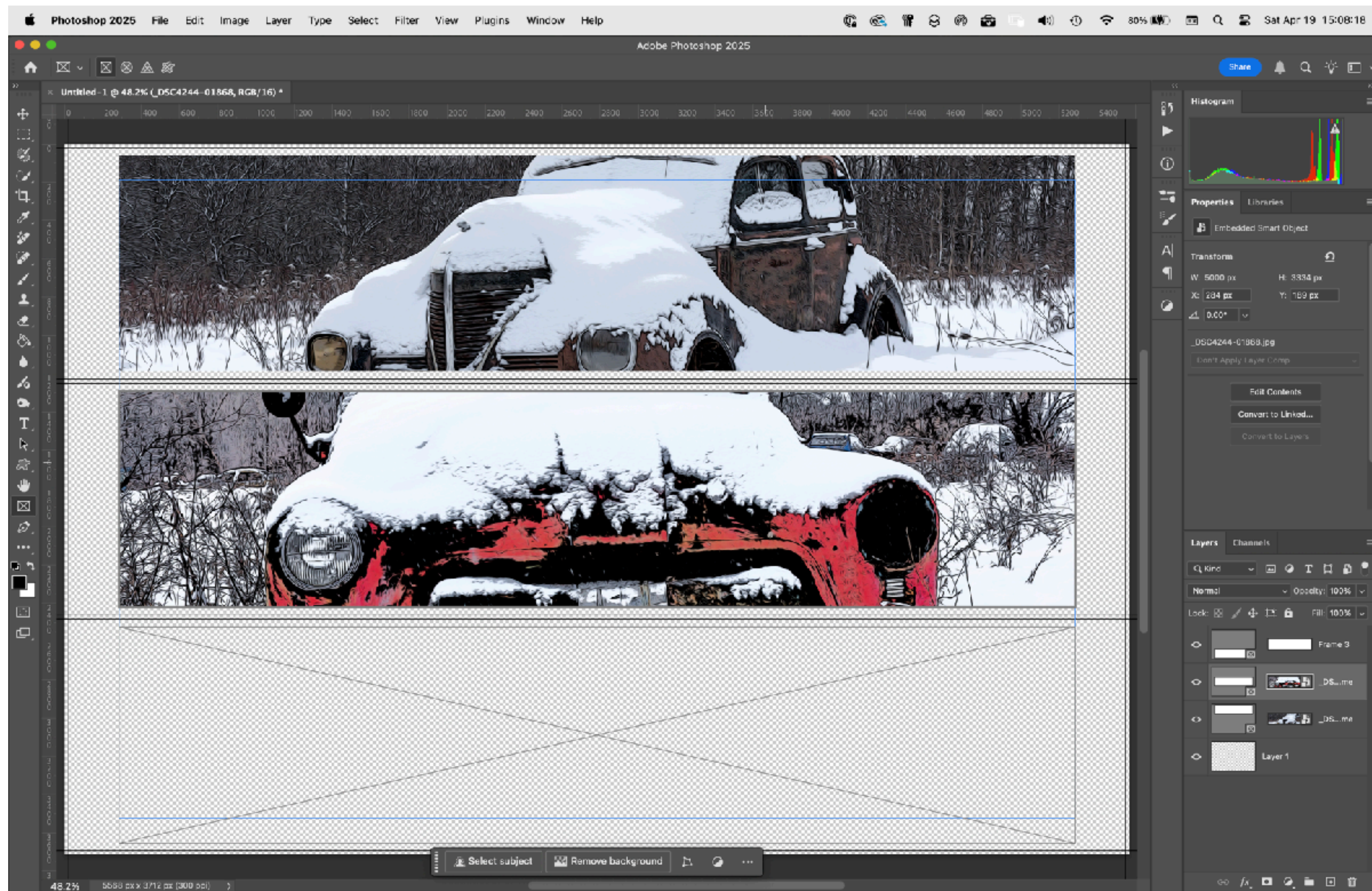
Frame

Resize the frames.

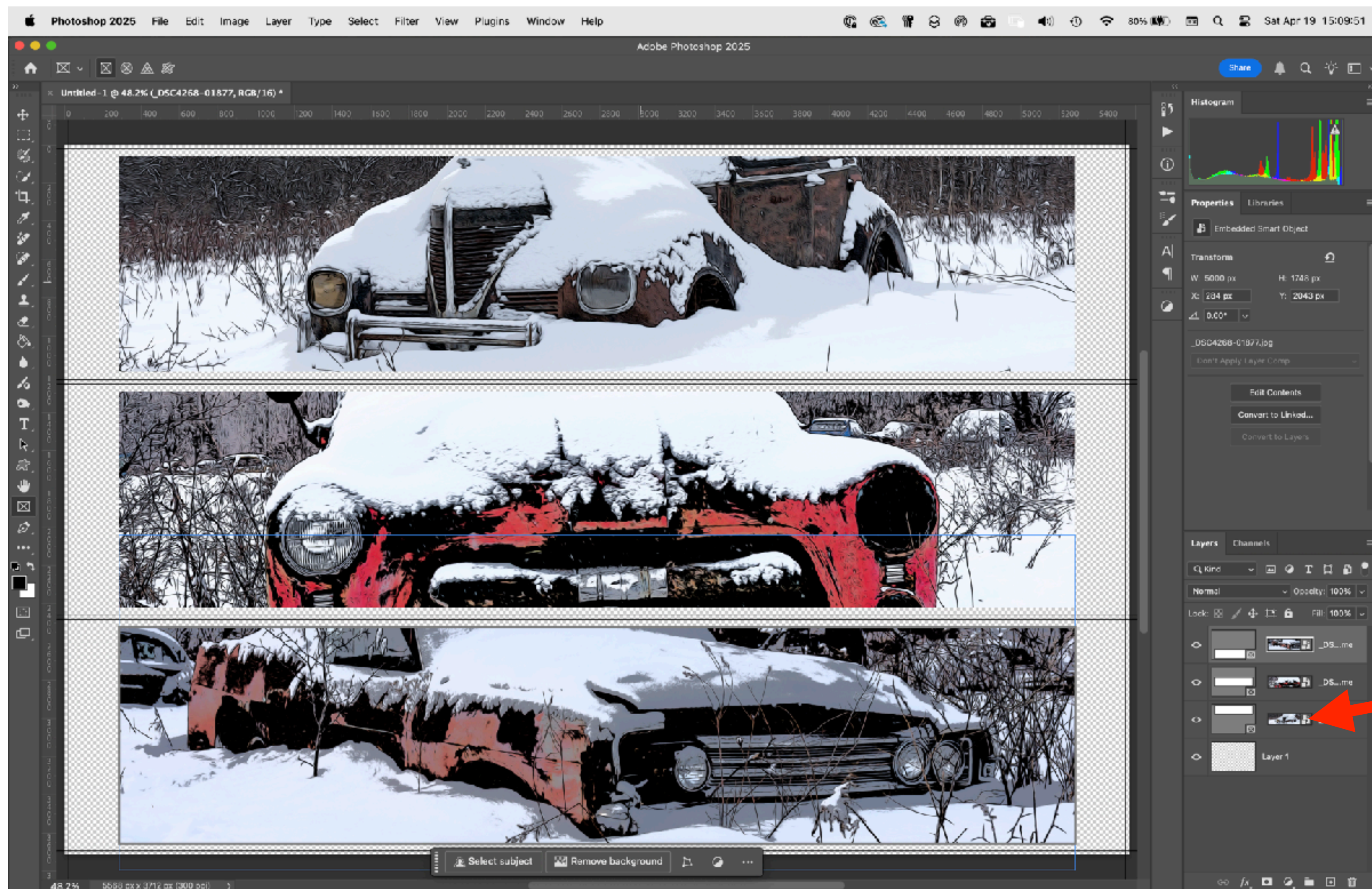
Tool bar for

Import your second image into one of the frames.

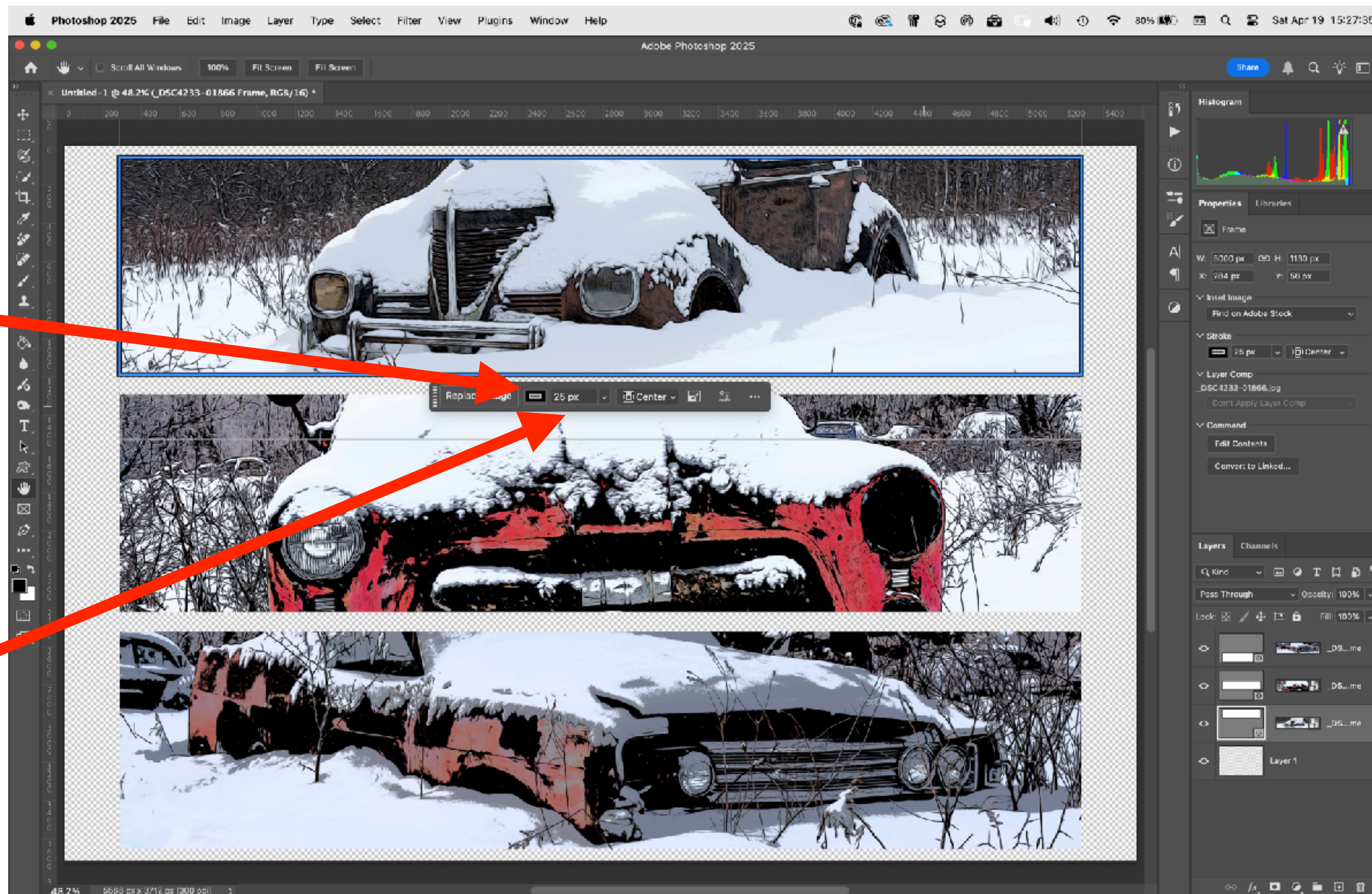

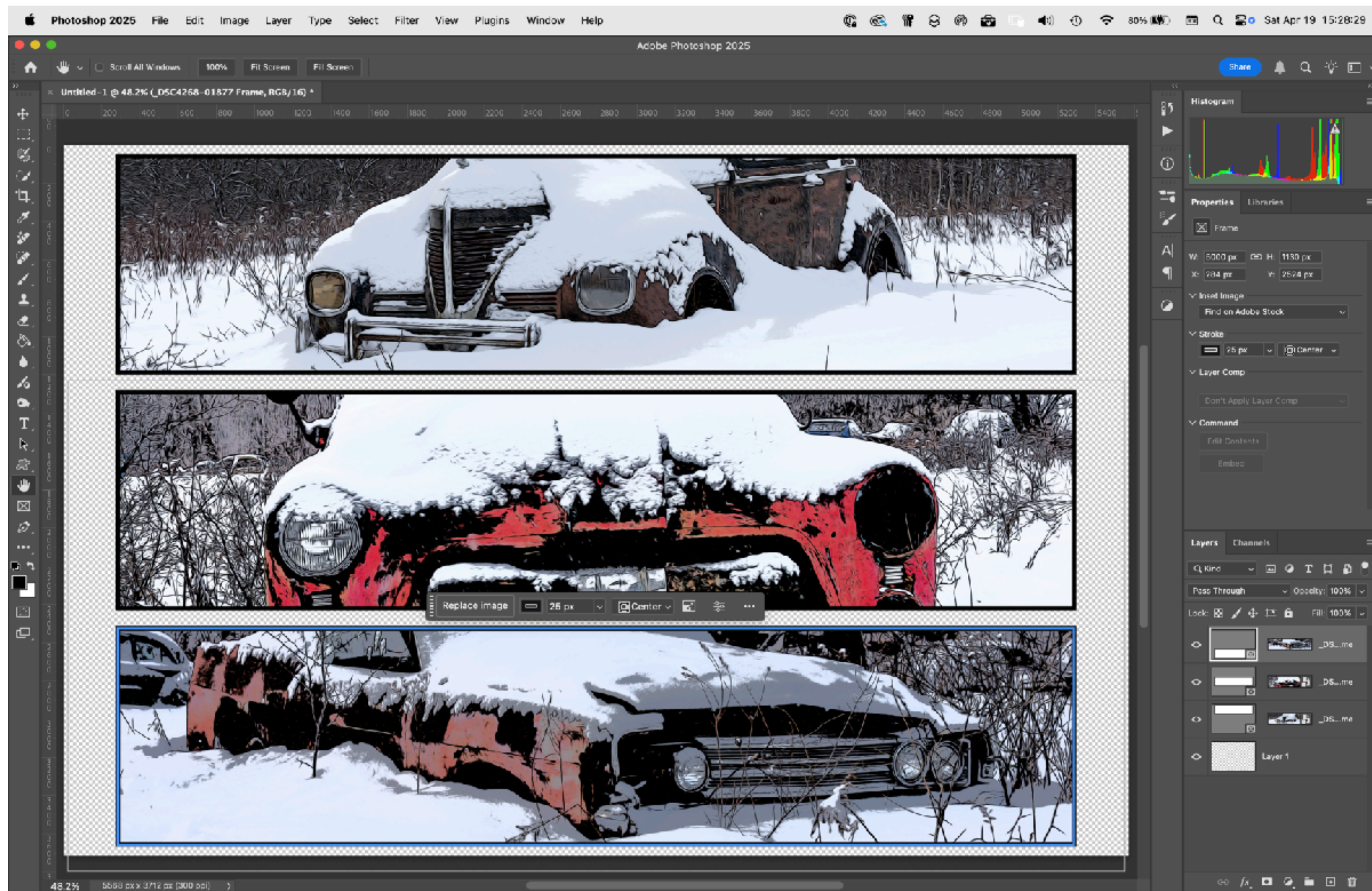
Import your last image into one of the frames.

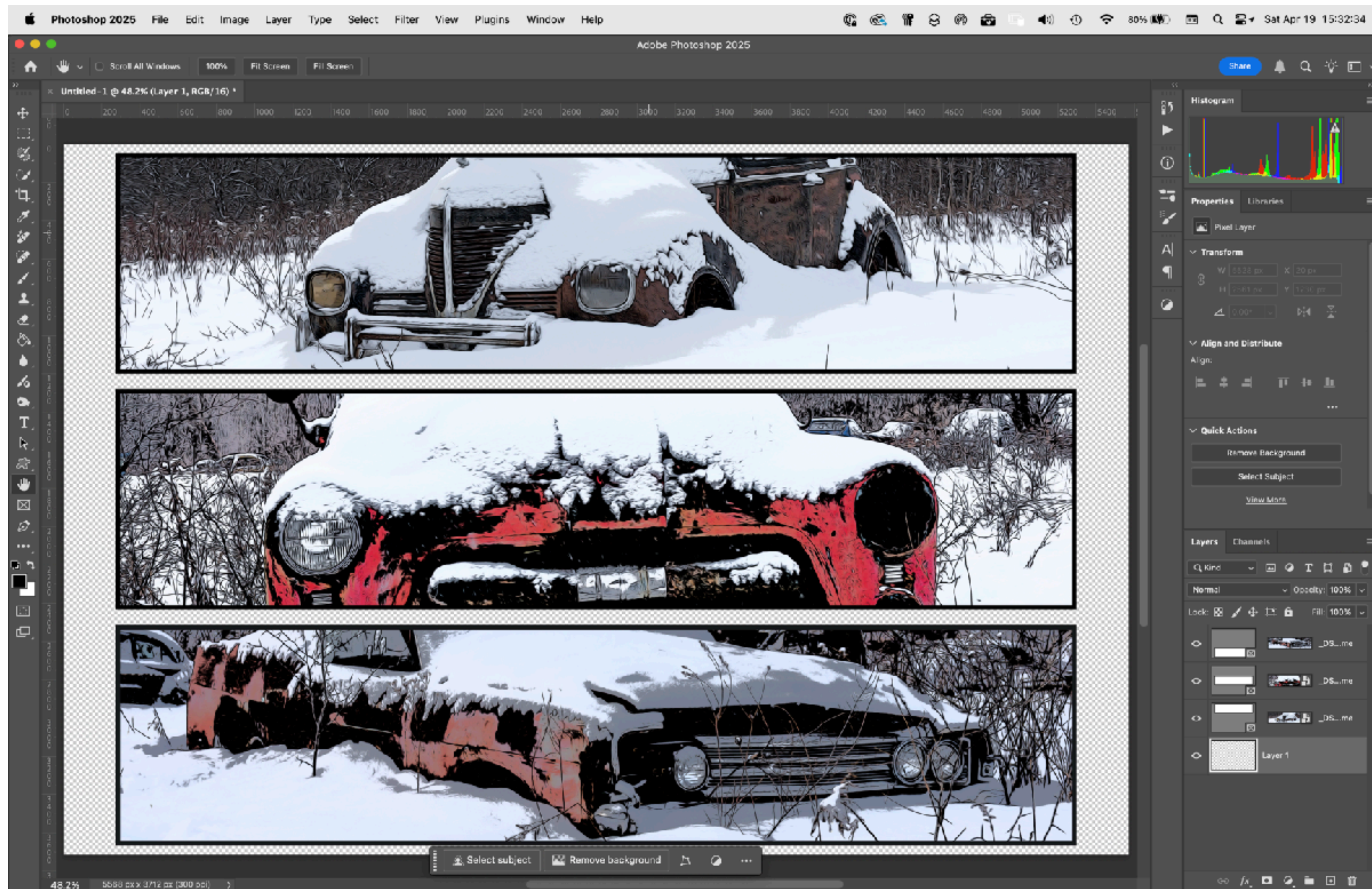
