a.k.a. Self Portrait


What is a "Selfie"

- A selfie or self portrait
 - An image of oneself taken or directed by the photographer
 - Informal to formal
 - "Taken by the photographer"
 - Hand-held phone camera with / without selfie-stick
 - Camera on a tripod or other support
 - Self timer, remote release or have someone else press the shutter release
 - "Directed by the photographer"
 - If someone else takes the picture, the photographer must direct the shoot
 - Subject takes care of all of the technical and compositional details of the shoot
 - Straight-out-of camera or post-processed
- Asking someone else to take your picture is not a selfie / self portrait



Albrecht Dürer - 1471–1528

- German Renaissance painter & print maker
- First artist to do multiple self-portraits
- Artists have been doing selfies for centuries



Robert Cornelius – 1839

 Considered to be one of the half-dozen most important early photographs

Untitled #98 - Cindy Sherman - 1982

- American contemporary fine art photographer
- Entire body of work is self-portraiture
 - Designs and makes her own costumes
 - Does her own hair and makeup
 - Creates her own scenes
 - Lighting design
 - Takes the pictures herself

FAQ


- Do I have to show my face?
 - Generally, a face is shown in a selfie
 - But not always
 - Examples
 - My shadow
 - Profile view
 - Back view
 - Part of the body
 - Hands of an artist and their artwork
 - Photo-composite
 - Must include some significant part of your body as the main subject
- Can there be other people in the shot?
 - Yes, but you must clearly be the main subject
- What is the difference between a formal and informal selfie?
 - Informal spontaneous / snapshot
 - Formal has more planning and control



Informal Self Portrait
